

USE ANTI-SEIZE LEAD-FREE COPPER PASTE (black tube)






REMOVAL OF STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEM:

Put the vehicle onto a car lift.

- ! CAUTION: ensure that the car is lifted safely and properly in order to avoid the risk of vehicle damage, injury, or even death!
- 1. Unscrew and carefully remove under engine panel, both rear wheels and rear wheel arch panels on both sides of the vehicle (F 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08).




- CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!
- IMPORTANT: loosen the marked clamp on both sides, before removing of the panel (F 02)!








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



- 2. Remove the marked reflectors, unscrew the marked bolts, disconnect all diffuser's connectors, unscrew the marked bolts and carefully remove the diffuser off the vehicle (F 09, 10, 11, 12, 13).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!






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







3. Unscrew the marked bolts, disconnect the rear lights' connectors, unscrew the lights' nuts and remove the lights, unscrew the marked bolts on both sides and carefully remove the rear bumper off the vehicle (F 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21).

CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




























- 4. Unscrew the marked nuts on both sides of the bumper and remove the tail pipes (F 22).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!



- 5. **For F8 Tributo only:** unscrew the marked bolts on both sides and remove the left, right and central engine compartment panels, off the vehicle **(F 23, 24).**
 - ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!








- 6. **For F8 Spyder only:** unscrew the marked bolts on both sides and remove the left, right and central engine compartment panels, off the vehicle (**F 25, 26**).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!









- 7. Disconnect the marked tube, connector, unscrew the tape clamp and marked bolts; carefully remove air mass flow sensors on both sides of the engine (F 27).
 - ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




- 8. Undo the marked OPF sensor tubes' clamps on both sides of the engine; carefully remove the tubes (F 28).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




- 9. Remove the marked vacuum tube off the actuators, on both sides of the engine (F 29).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




- 10. Unscrew the marked rubber brackets' nuts, on both sides of the engine (F 30).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




- 11. Remove the marked rubber brackets off the OPF pipes, on both sides of the engine (F 31).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!
- INSTALLATION TIP: for easier dismounting, lubricate the rubber brackets (WD40[®])*.




- 12. Unscrew the marked nuts on both sides and carefully remove the muffler off the vehicle (F 32).
- CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!



- 13. Loosen the marked clamps on both sides and carefully remove the OPF pipes off the vehicle (F 33).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




- 14. Unscrew the marked nuts and remove the OPF sensor pipes; unscrew the pipes' connection nut (F 34, 35).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!






- 15. Unscrew the marked bolt and clamp on both sides of the engine and carefully move both sound boosters out of the way (F 36).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!



- 16. Unscrew the two marked link pipes' bolts and loosen the three brackets' bolts on both sides of the engine (F 37).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




- 17. Unscrew the rear lambda sensors out of the both link pipes (F 38).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!



- 18. Unscrew the front lambda sensors out of the both link pipes, unscrew the marked clamps and carefully remove the link pipes out of the engine compartment (**F 39**).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




- 19. Carefully remove the marked gaskets out of the both link pipes (F 40).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




INSTALLATION OF THE AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEM:


- 1. Install the stock 8 mm (bigger of the two) OPF sensors' tubes and stock gaskets onto Akrapovič Link Pipes, as shown (F 41, 42, 43).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the exhaust during this process!









- 2. Carefully install both Akrapovič Link Pipes into the engine compartment, hand tighten them onto the brackets, using stock bolts, washers and nuts (F 44, 45).
 - IMPORTANT: use new stock gaskets in turbochargers Link Pipes joints.






- Align the Link Pipes, tighten the stock clamps and front lambda sensors, tighten all Link Pipes' bracket bolts and rear lambda sensors to the specified torques, on both sides of the engine (F 46, 47, 48).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!












- 4. Reinstall both sound boosters, as shown (F 49).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!



- Disconnect the (left side) OPF sensor's connector, unscrew the marked bolt, move the sensor (so you can access the OPF tube) and remove the marked stock OPF tube off the T-piece (F 50, 51, 52).
 - ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!









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
6. Rotate the stock OPF tube T-piece, so it points toward you and reinstall the sensor; install and secure the Akrapovič OPF rubber tube (using clamps and tie wraps from Akrapovič installation kit), as shown and tighten the stock metal tube (F 53, 54, 55, 56).

CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!













- 7. Remove the (right side) marked stock OPF tube off the sensor's T-piece (F 57, 58).
 - ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!










- 8. Install and secure the Akrapovič OPF rubber tube (using clamps and tie wraps from Akrapovič installation kit), as shown and tighten the stock metal tube (F 59, 60, 61, 62, 63).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!

















- Install the stock 6 mm (smaller of the two) OPF sensors' metal tubes and clamps (Akrapovič installation kit) onto Akrapovič outlet pipes, as shown (F 64, 65, 66).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the exhaust during this process!












- 10. Carefully install both outlet pipes onto link pipes and hand tighten the clamps (F 67, 68, 69, 70).
 - IMPORTANT: hand tighten the clamps only; do not fully tighten them yet!






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




- 11. Assemble the stock rubber brackets onto both Akrapovič outlet pipes, as shown (F 71).
- INSTALLATION TIP: for easier mounting, lubricate the rubber brackets (WD40[®])*.
 *WD-40[®] is a trademark of the WD-40 Company.



- 12. Tighten the stock rubber brackets onto chassis brackets on both sides of the engine, using stock washers and nuts (F 72).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!



- 13. Connect the stock vacuum tubes onto both vacuum actuators (F 73, 74).
- CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the exhaust system during this process!









14. Carefully install the muffler into the engine compartment, align the muffler and outlet pipes, install the V-clamps (Akrapovič installation kit) as shown and tighten all marked clamps on both sides of the engine, to the specified torques (F 75, 76).







15. Sound Kit components (F 77):

- 1 Sound kit unit
- 2 Power supply wire splice
- 3 Firewall rubber grommet
- 4- To right solenoid valve
- 5 Ground wire
- 6- To left stock connector
- 7 To left solenoid valve
- 8 Remote controller
- 9 Blind connector



- 16. Disconnect the stock right side stock solenoid connector, connect it to the Sound Kit blind connector, right side Sound Kit female connector to the solenoid valve and secure the connectors, as shown, using tie wraps from Akrapovič installation kit (F 78, 79).
 - ! IMPORTANT: make sure to secure the Sound Kit harness in such a way, that it won't touch any hot or moving parts of the vehicle!






17. Lead and secure (using tie wraps from Akrapovič installation kit) the left side Sound Kit harness to the left stock solenoid valve, as shown (F 80).






- 18. Disconnect the stock left side stock solenoid connector, connect it to the male left side Sound Kit connector, left side Sound Kit female connector to the solenoid valve and attach the ground wire to the chassis, as shown (F 81, 82, 83).
 - IMPORTANT: make sure to secure the Sound Kit harness in such a way, that it won't touch any hot or moving parts of the vehicle!






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- 19. Lead and secure (using tie wraps from Akrapovič installation kit) the Sound Kit harness towards the cockpit, as shown (F 84).
 - ! IMPORTANT: make sure to secure the Sound Kit harness in such a way, that it won't touch any hot or moving parts of the vehicle!



 For F8 Tributo only: remove the marked part of the left door seal, unscrew the marked bolts, disconnect the speaker and carefully remove the left B-column cover, to get access to electrical fuse box behind the drivers seat; check manufacturer workshop manual for correct disassembly (F 85, 86, 87, 88, 89).

CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!














- 21. For F8 Tributo only: unscrew the marked bolts and remove the fuse box cover (F 90).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!




22. For F8 Spyder only: remove the marked part of the left door seal, loosen the marked bolt, carefully remove the left B-column cover and disconnect the speakers, to get access to electrical fuse box behind the drivers seat; check manufacturer workshop manual for correct disassembly (F 91, 92, 93, 94, 95).









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- 23. For F8 Spyder only: unscrew the marked bolts and remove the fuse box cover (F 96).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!





- 24. For F8 Tributo only: lead the Sound Kit harness into the cockpit (F 97). There are two options (it depend's on your vehicle model):
 - **1. If marked stock rubber grommet is unused:** remove the stock grommet and install Akrapovič grommet together with harness.
 - 2. If marked stock rubber grommet is used for stock harness: carefully cut the Akrapovič grommet off the harness and lead the harness through the stock grommet, as shown (F 97).



- 25. For F8 Tributo only: locate the marked red-yellow wire behind the fuse box and crimp the wire splice on it, install and connect Sound Kit unit as shown (using tie wraps from Akrapovič installation kit (F 98, 99, 100).
 - ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or any part of the vehicle during this process!









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
- 26. For F8 Spyder only: unscrew the fuse box bolts and locate the marked red-yellow wire behind the fuse box (F 101, 102).
 - ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or any part of the vehicle during this process!





- 27. For F8 Spyder only: remove the marked fuse, sound kit unit and carefully cut the rubber grommet off the Akrapovič Sound Kit harness (F 103, 104).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or any part of the vehicle during this process!










28. For F8 Spyder only: lead the Sound Kit harness through the fire wall, as shown; remove the two marked stock rubber grommets, carefully cut them just enough, so you can get the Akrapovič harness through, than reinstall the stock grommets and fuse back in their place (F 105, 106, 107).

CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or any part of the vehicle during this process!







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29. **For F8 Spyder only:** lead the Sound Kit harness into the cockpit through the marked stock rubber grommet and secure the harness, as shown, using tie wraps from Akrapovič installation kit **(F 108, 109).**









For F8 Spyder only: crimp the wire splice on the marked red-yellow wire behind the fuse box, reinstall the fuse box, connect Sound Kit unit and secure all components, as shown, using tie wraps from Akrapovič installation kit (F 110, 111, 112).

CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or any part of the vehicle during this process!








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- 31. Install Akrapovič Tail Pipes onto the rear bumper, using stock washers and nuts (F 113, 114, 115, 116).
 - IMPORTANT: hand tighten the Tail Pipes only; do not fully tighten them yet!
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the vehicle during this process!















- 32. Reinstall the rear bumper onto the vehicle; check vehicle manufacturer workshop manual for correct procedures and tightening torques (F 117).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the exhaust system during this process!




- 33. Center and align the Tail Pipes in respect to rear bumper cutouts and outlet pipes; tighten the stock nuts to the specified torque (F 118).
 - ! IMPORTANT: make sure, not to damage tail pipes, bumper or any part of the vehicle during this process!



- 34. Reinstall the diffuser onto the vehicle; check vehicle manufacturer workshop manual for correct procedures and tightening torques (F 119).
 - CAUTION: make sure not to injure yourself or damage any part of the exhaust system during this process!



- 35. Check, if the Tail Pipes are centered in respect to the diffuser's cutouts; if that is not the case, redo the step 33. (F 120).
 - ! IMPORTANT: do not use the power/pressure washer for cleaning tail pipes; it can damage the tail pipe's surface!
- Reinstall all dismounted stock parts in reverse order; check vehicle manufacturer manual for correct procedures and tightening torques.





FINAL INSTALLATION:

- ! IMPORTANT: reinstall the dismounted or partially removed stock parts (wheel arches, bumper etc.); check vehicle manufacturer workshop manual for correct procedures and tightening torques.
- ! IMPORTANT: make sure all the nuts and bolts are sufficiently tightened. In case the Akrapovič product touches the cowling or other parts, repeat the adjustment of the product or contact your authorized dealer.
- ! IMPORTANT: clean all Akrapovič product's surfaces before the first start of the engine or the stains will burn onto the surfaces!
- ! IMPORTANT: in case any component of the Akrapovič product is equipped with DMC code sticker, the sticker and glue residue should be removed from the component, before first use!

MAINTENANCE OF THE AKRAPOVIČ PRODUCT:

- 1. Clean all Akrapovič product's surfaces. Cleaning will prevent spots from burning onto the surface. Do not use aggressive chemical cleaners, because they can damage the surface:
 - Titanium surfaces (titanium muffler's outer sleeve, titanium pipes etc): use a soft cloth sprayed with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40® or equivalent)*, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
 - Carbon-fiber surfaces (carbon-fiber outlet cap, carbon-fiber muffler's outer sleeve, carbon-fiber bracket etc): use a soft dry cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
 - Painted surfaces (painted outlet cap, painted muffler's outer sleeve, painted bracket etc):
 use a soft cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
 - Chrome plated surfaces (chrome plated outlet cap, chrome plated muffler's outer sleeve
 etc): use a soft cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
 - Stainless steel surfaces (stainless steel muffler's outer sleeve, stainless steel pipes etc):

Valves are not moving	No supply	Check green LED on the Control Kit. If the LED is off: Check electrical connection and connectors Check fuse for exhaust valves (in the trunk, right)
	Error detected	Check green LED on the Control Kit. If the LED blinks one time per period: Check Left input harness and connectors. If the LED blinks two times per period: Check Right Input harness and connectors. If the LED blinks three times per period: Check Left Output harness and connectors. If the LED blinks four times per period: Check Right Output harness and connectors. If the LED is continuously blinking: Check if CAN sniffer is properly installed. Check CAN sniffers connections and connector Period lasts approximately one second.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible cause	Solution
Remote Controller not working (red blinking then withe blinking)	Pairing process not successful	Do again the pairing process – check user manual
White LED blinking on the Sound Remote Controller	No communication with the receiver	While pressing on the Remote Controller, check if the green LED of the Sound Kit Receiver is green. If yes, then try to put the Sound Kit receiver in another position.
Red LED blinking on the Sound Remote Controller	There is communication with the receiver but there is some issue with the valve system	Switch off the car. Wait one minute and switch on the car.





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
